Rensselaer Central High School is a public high school located in Rensselaer, Indiana and is accredited by the Indiana Department of Education as well as by AdvancED. The current 2023-2024 enrollment for RCHS is 468 students in grades 9-12. RCHS is on a traditional 7-period day schedule. Students receive one credit per semester for each course successfully completed unless the credit count is noted differently on the transcript.

The community and the surrounding school district are located in northwest Indiana approximately 80 miles south of downtown Chicago and 90 miles north of Indianapolis near Interstate 65. The economy of the community is based on agriculture and several small industries. Rensselaer is the county seat of Jasper County and has a population of approximately 6400 residents and supports new growth opportunities. The community reflects a strong tradition of support for academic, cultural, and athletic achievement.

Honors/Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

RCHS offers 6 Honors and 8 Advanced Placement courses to provide opportunities for students to select intense coursework including English, Math, Science, Social Studies and Spanish.

Dual Credit RCHS offers 27 courses for college credit through Ivy Tech. These include Math, Social Studies, and several CTE classes.

Industrial Tech RCHS has graduation pathways in Agriculture, Aviation, Construction, Business, Education, Health Science, Manufacturing, Public Safety and Transportation
